Hand Sanitizer Use and Permission to Apply Sunscreen at School

Delaware Department of Education (DOE), guidelines require parent/guardian permission for school age children to use alcohol-based hand sanitizer in school settings. These guidelines require a parent/guardian signature to be kept on file and for hand sanitizer to be kept out of the reach of children and to be only used under supervision. **Please refrain from putting a bottle of hand sanitizer in or on your child's backpack or jacket.** All hand sanitizer at Sussex Montessori will be used under the guidance of staff.

Please apply sunscreen to your child every morning before school. As needed throughout the day, **your child's teacher will assist** with applying sunscreen to bare surfaces including the face, tops of ears, bare shoulders, arms, legs, and feet 15-30 min before outdoor activity. Sunscreen will not be applied to any broken skin or if a skin reaction has been observed. Any skin reaction observed by staff will be reported promptly to the parent/guardian and the child will be sent to the school nurse.
