Call to Order at 5:31 p.m.

Minutes

A motion was made by Dean Swingle and seconded by Tom Thunstrom to approve the April 20, 2021, Minutes.

Operating Budget presentation

- Michelle presented revenue as of June 30, 2021, noting that 101.32% of budgeted revenues have been received.
- Michelle also noted that there was one student that we were unable to count and returned the funds to the local district.
- Michelle then went over state and local expenditures noting that we are at 80.97% of the year.
- Michelle discussed federal revenues grants budgeted and received.
- The school ended up with \$758,000 in cash, exceeding our financial framework and ended very strong! We are going to use a zero-based budget and live within our means for daily operations.
- Michelle presented the pcard (credit card) expenditures totaling \$19,017.55.

Facilities

- Jessica presented the June 30, 2021, Phase 2 financial statement total unrestricted cash and loan funds available is \$1,850,241.31.
- Jessica outlined the classroom budget expecting to spend \$2,280,879; August 17, 2021, is the projected completion date.
- Jessica indicated we are also managing some smaller projects to facilitate at the site barn and porch stabilization.
- Linda noted we need to raise additional funds (approximately \$2M for four new classrooms by 2023) and do not want to take on any more debt.

A motion to adjourn was made by Tom Thurston and seconded by Edwin Santos. The motion passed unanimously with no objections and no abstentions at 6:05 p.m.
