<sup>1</sup> Requests for good cause withdrawal must be made, in writing, and approved by the Sussex Montessori School Board.

Reasons for withdrawal:

1. a change in a child’s residence due to a change in family residence
2. a change in the state in which the family residence is located
3. a change in the marital status of the child’s parents
4. a change caused by a guardianship proceeding
5. placement of a child in foster care
6. adoption
7. participation by a child in a foreign exchange program
8. participation by a child in a substance abuse or mental health treatment program
9. a reported, recorded and substantiated instance of “bullying” against their child as defined in § 4161 of this Delaware Title 14
10. a set of circumstances consistent with this definition of “good cause”
